

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

An aquifer pumping test is proposed for an undeveloped lot located in the City of Sunset. The purpose of the test is to obtain groundwater flow characteristics data in support of future clean up activities for Operable Unit 5 (OU 5) at Hill Air Force Base, Utah. These activities are part of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) process for the operable unit. This environmental baseline survey was conducted to document the condition of the off-base property before a lease is obtained for well installation.

No evidence of contamination originating from the pumping test site was discovered by a records search, direct site inspection or a property owner interview. The plume affecting groundwater beneath the pumping test site is associated with a source located on Hill Air Force Base (Hill AFB) property. Based on the findings of this survey, it is recommended that property lease arrangements proceed.
